CASUALTY STATISTICS AND INVESTIGATIONS

Very serious and serious casualties for the year 2002

1 The Sub-Committee on Flag State Implementation (FSI), at its eighth (24 to 28 January 2001) and tenth (8 to 12 April 2002) sessions, agreed that the lists of very serious and serious casualties to be investigated as soon as identified, using the data received from Rescue Co-ordination Centres (RCCs) in the form of situation reports (SITREPs) and other sources, should be prepared in the form of FSI circulars and made available, together with other casualty-related data, in an electronic format on the IMO web server (FSI 8/19, paragraph 11.17 and FSI 10/17, paragraphs 9.18 and 9.21).

2 The Marine Environment Protection Committee, at its forty-third (19 to 28 May 1999) and forty-eighth (7 to 11 October 2002) sessions, and the Maritime Safety Committee, at its seventy-first (19 to 28 May 1999) and seventy-sixth (2 to 13 December 2002) sessions, endorsed the Sub-Committee's instruction to the Secretariat to publish information on casualties on the IMO website after its content has been agreed by the FSI Sub-Committee (MSC 71/23, paragraph 10.3, MEPC 43/21, paragraph 8.6, MEPC 48/21, paragraph 9.3.17 and MSC 76/23, paragraph 9.7).

3 Attached, as annex 1, is a list of selected "very serious" and "serious casualties" for the year 2002.

4 Attached, as annex 2, are statistics on total losses of ships of 100 GT and above and losses of lives as a consequence to the total losses, as compiled on the basis of data^{*} available at the time of issuance of the circular.

5 The information contained in the electronic version of the circular will be updated when additional information becomes available and is recorded in IMO's relevant databases.

* The main sources of data for the preparation of annex 2 were the World Casualty Statistics (LRF) and the Lloyd's Casualty Week publication (LMIU).
